- The concert starts at **7pm** and the doors will be open from 6.45pm. Tickets can be obtained on the door if you have not already purchased at rehearsals £6 for adults and £3 for children/concessions.
- Choir are to wear normal concert attire black t-shirts and trousers/skirts if wearing skirts please wear black tights. Black shoes must also be worn.
- The concert will end around 8.30pm.
- Parking in Maltese Road is possible.
